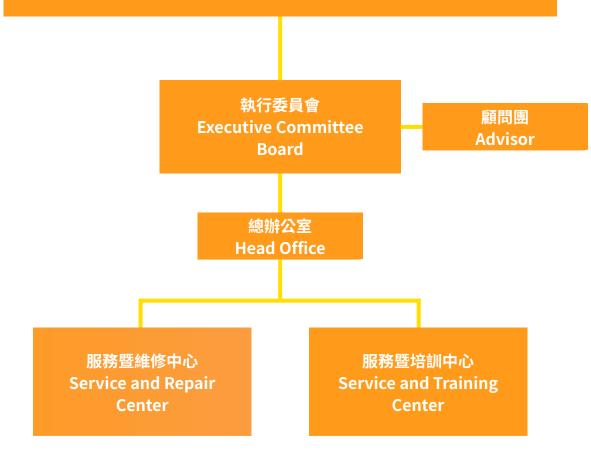

本會一直致力為全港傷健人士、其照顧者及有需要人士提供專業且可靠的助行器具維修服務,涵蓋手推輪椅、沖涼椅及助行架等。在本年度,機構一共處理了超過3500宗維修個案。

本會的助行工具租借及轉讓服務得以推行,有賴社會各界的慷慨捐贈,其中包括手推輪椅、沖涼椅、助行架及其他助行工具。本會技師會根據物資的性能及狀況進行檢測評估,並由本會提供租借或轉讓服務,讓有需要人士可免費短期租借或以較實惠的價格購買適合且安全的助行工具,以減輕經濟負擔。

此外,本會亦會分拆部分損壞物資中的零件作維修用途,以延長使用壽命,減少資源浪費。本年度,本會已成功為超過2500人次提供各類輔助工具租借服務。

「賽馬會耆義樂輪計劃」由香港賽馬會慈善信託基金捐助推行,透過培訓 銀齡義工服務居於住宅並領取綜援或長者生活津貼的長者,維修手推輪椅 及轉贈二手手推輪椅。義工隊會定期探訪慰問長者及檢查輪椅輔助工具安 全,支援長者居家安老,同時加強銀齡長者與社會聯繫。

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Hong Kong Wheelchair Aid Service Limited ("the Company") set out on pages 5 to 11, which comprise the statement of financial position as at 31 March 2025, the income statement and the statement of changes in equity for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the financial statements of the Company are prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the Hong Kong Small and Medium-Sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard ("SME-FRS") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA") and have been properly prepared in compliance with the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing ("HKSAs") and with reference to PN 900 (Revised) Audit of Financial Statements Prepared in Accordance with the Small and Medium-Sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard issued by the HKICPA. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the HKICPA's Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants ("the Code"), and we have fulfilled our other responsibilities in accordance with the Code. NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Hong Kong Wheelchair Aid Service Limited is a company limited by guarantee and not having a share capital, domiciled and incorporated in Hong Kong. The address of its registered office and principal place of operation are Units 1-3, G/F, Cheong Him House, Nam Cheong Estate, Sham Shui Po, Kowloon, Hong Kong. The Company is a charitable organization principally engaged in providing assistance, including daily housework, repairs and maintenance of equipment as well as emergency help, the needy wheelchair users.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Company qualifies for the reporting exemption as a small guarantee company under section 359(1)(a) of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622) and is therefore entitled to prepare and present its financial statements in accordance with the Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard (SME-FRS) issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

These financial statements comply with the SME-FRS and have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the company is a going concern. They are presented in Hong Kong dollars.

The measurement base adopted is the historical cost convention.

The following are the specific accounting policies that are necessary for a proper understanding of the financial statements:

a. Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and permanent impairment.

Depreciation on property, plant and equipment is provided to write off their costs on a reducing balance basis over their estimated useful lives with principal annual rates as follows:

Furniture, fixtures & equipment 20% Leasehold improvement 20% Motor vehicle 20%

b. Impairment of assets

An assessment is made at each date of statement of financial position to determine whether there is any indication of impairment or reversal of previous impairment, including items of property, plant and equipment, intangible assets and long-term investments. In the event that an asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount, the carrying amount is reduced to recoverable amount and an impairment loss is recognized in the statement of comprehensive income. A previously recognized impairment loss is reversed only if there has been a change in the estimates used to determine the recoverable amount, however not to an amount higher than the carrying amount that would have been determined (net of amortization or depreciation), had no impairment losses been recognized for the asset in prior years.

Investments and insurance policy account value
 Long term investments are stated at cost less accumulated impairment losses.

The account value of insurance policy is stated on the value before surrender of the insurance policy.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

d. Taxation

The Company is a recognized charitable institution and is exempted from tax.

e. Operating leases

Rental payable under operating leases are charged to the statement of comprehensive income on a straight-line basis over the terms of the relevant leases.

f. Revenue recognition

- Donations, subsidies and receipts from fund raising activities are recognized on accrued basis when receipt thereof is certain. Otherwise, they are recognized on cash basis.
- ii) Service income is recognized upon provision of services.
- iii) Interest income is recognized on a time proportion basis taking into account the principal outstanding and the interest applicable.

g. Government grants and subvention

Government grants and subvention are recognized as income over the periods which match the costs to which it relates. Grants related to expense items are recognized in the same period as the expenses to which it relates are charged in the income statement.

h. Retirement benefit scheme

The retirement benefit coasts charged to the income statement represents contributions payable in respect of the current year to the Company's Mandatory Provident Fund Scheme.

i. Provisions and contingent liabilities

Provisions are recognized for liabilities of uncertain timing or amount when the Company has a legal or constructive obligation arising as a result of a past event, it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made. Where the time value of money is material, provisions are stated at the present value of the expenditure to settle the obligation.

Where it is not probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required, or the amount cannot be estimated reliably, the obligation is disclosed as a contingent liability, unless the probable of outflow of economic benefits is remote. Possible obligations, whose existence will only be confirmed by the occurrence or non-occurrence of one or more future events are also disclosed as contingent liability unless the probability of outflow of economic benefits is remote.

j. Foreign currency translations

Foreign currency transactions during the year are converted into Hong Kong dollars at rates of exchange ruling at the transaction dates. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies at the date of statement of financial position are translated into Hong Kong dollars at the rates of exchange ruling at that date. Any exchange differences are dealt with in the profit or loss account.

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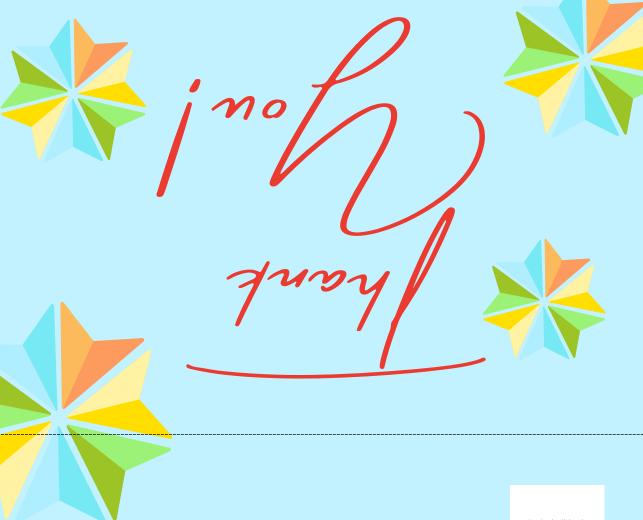
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
